Fellow Prime Time Plus Club Members:

I am sure we have all heard many people sharing their stories of Prime Time's trips, especially about the recent trips to Kenya. While we love hearing about all the fun our members had while traveling, there are also stories from these trips that not as many people might know

about; specifically, the lasting impact our Prime Time Plus Club members can have on the communities they visit.

Both of our Prime Time's tour groups to Kenya had the opportunity to visit Emarti Secondary School, located near Emarti Village in the Trans-Mara District. The Emarti school system includes an elementary program serving more than 700 students, and a secondary school with more than 100 students who live in on-site dormitories.

During their visits, Prime Time members joined students to plant trees, tour classrooms, learn about daily school life, and talk to them about their future career paths. While our members were there, the school was fundraising to complete a library collection for their students and needed about \$3,000 more to reach their goal.

Thanks to the generosity of our Prime Time Plus Club members, the school's goal was fully met after our visits! The school's library is now fully stocked, providing students with the books and resources they need to support their learning. It will make a significant impact on their community.

I would also like to share one more special story from our PTPC visits to Emarti that shows the powerful impact our trips can have on the communities we visit. While at the school, one of our Prime Time members spoke with a guide who mentioned that restroom facilities were not available to visitors as they needed full replacement.

Shortly before our visit to Kenya, this same member had lost his father. His parents had traveled later in their lives, but his father was a reluctant traveler. The PTPC member's trip to Kenya mirrored the Kenya trip his parents took, which struck a chord with the member. His father always spoke very fondly of Kenya and often described it as his favorite destination. During his Kenya trip, his father formed a friendship with a local guide, who gifted him a traditional war club, a keepsake our member still treasures.

After leaving the school, moved by both the memory of his father and the current needs of the community, our member was inspired to do something meaningful. After discussing it with his wife, they decided to make a generous donation from his father's estate to fund the construction of new restroom facilities for the school. This project, which was completed last June, includes ten toilet stalls and a new water tank—creating a lasting and much-needed improvement for the school, its students, and visitors.

This story shows the positive impact all of us can have, not just in our own community, but in the communities we visit all around the world. Thank you for being a member of Prime Time and for traveling with us.
